

Diversey Notice: Temporary Oil Surcharge Effective May 1, 2026

We are notifying you of a temporary price increase.

Due to the conflict in the Middle East, oil prices have experienced a record-breaking surge (from \$70-\$114+) which is driving higher energy, transportation and manufacturing costs.

Petrochemical feedstocks, such as solvents, surfactants, polymers and chelates, are also surging in cost due to oil prices and supply constraints. These increases are now reflected in current costs throughout our supply chain.

Despite ongoing efforts to offset these impacts through operational efficiencies and sourcing actions, the magnitude of the cost escalation can no longer be fully absorbed. Therefore, effective May 1, 2026, we will implement a temporary energy surcharge of 7%–12% on all end user pricing templates.

This is a temporary, transparent mechanism intended to reflect today's extraordinary energy and feedstock costs while allowing us to maintain safe, reliable operations and continuity of supply. We will review the surcharge regularly and adjust it —or remove it—when underlying costs stabilize.

Please note:

- This adjustment reflects current, realized cost increases, not anticipated future movements.
- The surcharge will be reviewed regularly. Because cost changes flow through inventory and contracted freight with a timing lag, please allow approximately 30–60 days for the surcharge to be fully reflected, and a similar 30–60 days for it to unwind after costs normalize.
- Our priority remains uninterrupted supply, consistent quality, and responsive service during this period of volatility.
